



RECLAMATION: How did you recover, make use of or reclaim your time and energy while in isolation over the course of the last two years? Did you meditate, pray, exercise or in other ways try to connect with your own interior world (and support yourself from the anxiety of the exterior world) and how did that inform your work? How did the pandemic shape your daily practice and how did it change?

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all artists over the age of 18 residing in Florida. Only original artwork will be accepted. Categories are, painting (including oil, acrylic, collage, watercolor and mixed media), drawing, photography, sculpture, ceramics, metalsmithing, glass, digital media, video, printmaking, fiber or textiles. An entry consists of 1 to 3 artworks. There is no entry fee for submitted work.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY: All entries must be submitted no later than **Feb 1 by 5pm**. No materials will be accepted at the gallery until your work is accepted for the exhibition. Send digital images of artwork to salexander@SJRState.edu in JPG or PNG format. File size limit is 5MB. Please name files as follows:

All 2D artwork must be wired and ready to hang and not exceed six feet in any direction. All 3D artwork must not exceed six feet in any direction or 150 lbs. All artwork must have been completed in the last two years and not previously shown at the College.

The work must be dropped off and picked up in person, no shipping.

LIABILITY: Every effort will be made to handle with care, including protection from loss. Florida School of the Arts will not be liable for loss or damage caused or occurring while work is exhibited. Submission of any artwork constitutes an agreement to all conditions of this entry form, including schedule and permission to photograph for publicity purposes. Signature on the entry form is an agreement to these conditions.

SALES: As an institution for education, there is no commission on sales and any inquiries will be directed to the artist.
